**Graduation Requirements:** In addition to Required Courses listed on the first page, each student must complete courses listed in one of the boxes on pages 4-7 to equal at least 120 credits, with a minimum overall GPA of 2.0000 and a minimum in-major GPA of 2.0000.

For purposes of GPA computation, courses included IN-MAJOR are courses listed in the DEGREE CORE on page 1, APSC 4004 and ALS 3104 in the Pathway to General Education on page 1, and designated (+) courses in all options on pages 4-7.

+These courses are included in the in-major GPA calculation; \*MATH 1025 is the pre-requisite for PHYS 2205; \*\* These credits will NOT be included in the calculation of the in-major GPA; \*\*\*A grade of C or better is required.

#These courses have prerequisites and /or corequisites; please consult the University Course Catalog or check with your advisor.

An APSC degree may be earned in combination with the first year of work in an accredited medical, dental, or veterinary school, provided that the following requirements are met: at least two of the three years of pre-professional work, including the third year, are in residence at VT; and a minimum of 90 semester credits of undergraduate work that include all the courses listed above as Pathway to General Education and Degree Core, and at least 1 handling lab and 1 production course.

**Progress Towards Degree Policy:** Upon the completion of 72 credits, APSC students must have completed CHEM 1036 and 1046, APSC 1454 and 1464, and 6 credits from ALS 2304, 3104, or 3204; have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0; and have completed at least 24 credits that apply to the Pathway to General Education requirements.

**Foreign Language Requirement:** Two semesters of a single foreign language are required unless 2 units of a single foreign language are completed in high school. These credits do not count toward graduation requirements.
